Further information

University degree certificates and transcript of records

- In the case of foreign higher education and university certificates, the grading system used at the foreign institution of higher education must be taken from the attached Transcript of Records, as this is required to determine the German equivalent grade. The grading system must indicate both the minimum and maximum grades to be achieved.
- If the degree has not been obtained by the end of the application period, a provisional certificate from the university with all the work completed by this deadline must be submitted + provisional transcripts of records

Letter of motivation (in English or Spanish)

- max. 2 pages, Arial 10, line spacing 1,5
- Must explain the specific motivation for applying for the master's program "Communication and Society in Ibero-America" referring to the applicant's thematic and regional areas of interest. It should answer questions such as the following:
 - Why do you want to participate in this master's program and what interests you especially about the program?
 - What is your educational/scientific background and how does it relate to the master's program?
 - What do you expect from the master's program?

Proof of Proficiency in English (level C1 according to CEFRL)

- Potential proof:
 - University entrance qualification or University degree from an English speaking country or an English language university degree
 - An undergraduate university degree with at least 50% of English philology (or related subjects)
 - A minimum score of 90 in the internet-based **TOEFL**
 - A minimum score of 7.0 in the **IELTS**
 - Certificate of a C1 level from the Heidelberg University's Language Centre
 - Other certificate (If you have a certificate that is not listed above, please contact us at [study\(at\)hcias.uni-heidelberg.de](mailto:study(at)hcias.uni-heidelberg.de))

Proof of Proficiency in Spanish (level B2 according to CEFRL)

- Potential proof:
 - University entrance qualification or University degree from a Spanish speaking country or a Spanish language university degree
 - An undergraduate university degree with at least 25% of Spanish philology (or related subjects)
 - **DELE** from the Instituto Cervantes certifying a B2 Nivel Avanzado
 - Certificate of a B2 level from the Heidelberg University's Language Centre
 - Other certificate (If you have a certificate that is not listed above, please contact us at [study\(at\)hcias.uni-heidelberg.de](mailto:study(at)hcias.uni-heidelberg.de))

Statement about ongoing examinations

- A statement as to whether the applicant has definitively failed an examination in the master's program or in related programs with essentially the same content or whether the applicant is no longer entitled to participate in the examinations for other reasons, or whether the applicant is in an ongoing examination process for a similar program.
