The Universidad de Buenos Aires (UBA) is Argentina's largest and most prestigious public university, founded in 1821. With over 300,000 students across 13 faculties, UBA consistently ranks among the top universities in Latin America.

Through a cooperation agreement with the <u>Facultad de Filosofía y Letras</u> (FFyL), HCIAS exchange students can take deepen their knowledge in the areas of **discourse analysis** or **Latin American culture**. While selected candidates are exempt from tuition fees for international students, they will still be required to pay the regular administrative fees of the FFyL.



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Universidade Federal de Minas Gerais, Brazil

The Universidade Federal de Minas Gerais (UFMG) is one of the leading federal public universities in Brazil. The main campus is located in Belo Horizonte, the capital of the state of Minas Gerais, with a population of over 2 million inhabitants.

For HCIAS Master's students applying for the exchange with the UFMG, we suggest to consider courses of the Faculdade de Filosofia e Ciências Humanas in the areas of Social Communication, Anthropology, Sociology, and Political Science.

As courses are generally taught in Portuguese, proficiency in the language is a prerequisite for participation in the exchange program. To help incoming students prepare, UFMG offers a preparatory Portuguese course at the start of their stay in Belo Horizonte.

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
Pontifícia Universidade Católica do Paraná, Brazil

The <u>Pontifícia Universidade Católica do Paraná (PUCPR)</u> is a private Catholic university located in the capital of Paraná, Curitiba. The city is widely known as a leader in sustainable urban planning.

For HCIAS Master's students interested in a stay at PUCPR, we recommend pursuing an **internship** at the university.

As knowledge of Portuguese is essential for a stay in Brazil, proficiency in the language is a prerequisite for participation in the program.

The Universidade de São Paulo (USP), with more than 90,000 students, is Brazil's largest public university and considered one of the most prestigious universities in Latin America. It has eleven campuses across the state of São Paulo, with four of them located in Brazil's biggest metropolis, São Paulo.

Through a general agreement between Heidelberg University and the Universidade de São Paulo, HCIAS students have the opportunity to participate in an exchange program, taking courses across a broad range of fields such as environmental studies, social anthropology, and political science.

As courses are generally taught in Portuguese, proficiency in the language is a prerequisite for participation in the exchange program.



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Pontificia Universidad Javeriana, Colombia

For HCIAS Master's students applying for an exchange with the Pontificia Universidad Javeriana, recommended fields include the programs offered at the <u>Facultad de Comunicación y Lenguaje</u>, <u>Facultad de Ciencias Políticas y Relaciones Internacionales</u>, or at the <u>Facultad de Ciencias Sociales</u>.

As the oldest still existing university in the state of Costa Rica, the Universidad de Costa Rica is the largest institution of higher education in the country. The university's main campus, Ciudad Universitaria Rodrigo Facio, is located near San José, the capital of the country, with additional regional campuses throughout the country.

The UCR is the ideal choice for HCIAS students looking to deepen their knowledge in different social sciences such as **Anthropology**, **Sociology** or **Political Science** offered by the <u>Facultad de Ciencias</u> <u>Sociales</u>, but also in **Linguistics** at the <u>Facultad de Artes y Letras</u>.

To be eligible for the exchange program with the UCR, interested students must have completed the first year of the master's programs.

Through cooperation agreements with the **Facultad de Comunicación e Imagen** and the **Facultad de Gobierno**, HCIAS students have the opportunity to deepen their knowledge in areas such as social or political communication, but also regional or public administration.

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
Universidad Autónoma de Nuevo León, Mexico

The Universidad Autónoma de Nuevo León (UANL) is a public state university with campuses across Nuevo León. With over 200,000 students, it is the third-largest university in Mexico and a key center for higher education in the country. The Mederos Campus, home to most social science programs, is located in the south of Monterrey - a major industrial hub and Mexico's ninth-largest city.

Through an agreement with the <u>Facultad de Ciencias Políticas y Relaciones</u> <u>Internacionales</u>, HCIAS students have the opportunity to delve deeper into the areas of International Relations and Political Science.

For HCIAS Master's students applying for an exchange with UDG, we recommend taking courses at the <u>Centro Universitario de Ciencias</u> <u>Económico Administrativas</u> with a focus on Public Management and Communication or at the <u>Centro Universitario de Ciencias Sociales y</u> <u>Humanidades</u> specializing in Cultural Studies or Linguistics.



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Universidad de Salamanca, Spain

Focus area: Linguistics | Romance Language Studies | Ibero-American Studies **Benefits:** No tuition fees at host institution & ERASMUS mobility grant

Semester Period: September – December | February – June

As one of the oldest European universities, the Universidad de Salamanca (USAL) is among the most prestigious universities in Spain. Located in the western part of the country near the Portuguese border, the city of Salamanca is a historical hub for Spanish language and culture and a UNESCO World Heritage site.

The stay in Salamanca offers the opportunity to deepen knowledge in the linguistic field through courses on Linguistics or on Spanish Literature at the **Facultad de Filología** or the university's program in **Ibero-American Studies**.

The exchange with USAL is part of the ERASMUS program, therefore students would not only be exempt from tuition fees but would also receive an ERASMUS mobility grant.



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
